



## Uniform Policy and Expectations

The school uniform is to be worn during each school day unless special activity days are announced. Students are expected to wear the uniform to and from school. We encourage our students to take pride in their uniforms as a reflection of their pride in the school.

**All school uniforms must be purchased from Trutex clothing shop or online at [trutex.ae](http://trutex.ae) (school code MWIS-0011). PE uniforms should be purchased from Trutex.** There will be no exceptions to this rule. Students should be well-groomed, have a neat appearance, and wear a well-maintained school uniform.

### **PRIMARY (GRADES KG1-6)**

Standard School Uniform – to be purchased through Trutex

- Primary students will wear red MCIS polo shirts. MCIS shorts (boys) and skirts or pants (girls).
- Girls may wear leggings under skirts. These should be plain and complement the uniform colours (white or red).
- Must wear shoes, not sandals and should be closed-toe. Crocs are not permitted.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- Standard school uniform must be worn at all times except on PE days. On PE days, Primary students should wear their PE uniform to school.

Hoodies/Jacket/Sweater – to be purchased through Trutex

- Only official school hoodies, jackets and sweaters may be worn.
- Students may wear existing MCIS jumpers/hoodies purchased through Trutex, the Parent Team or MCIS hoodies.
- Non-MCIS jumpers, sweaters, hoodies are not permitted.

PE Uniform – to be purchased through Trutex

- Standard PE uniform is the PE shirt and shorts or tracksuit bottoms purchased through Trutex.
- Early Years students should wear their PE uniform on days that they have PE.

Hair/Headwear and Jewellery

- Hair should be neat and not of a distracting nature to the student or others.
- Jewelry should be minimal and plain (no dangling earrings).
- Items such as shaylas, belts and hair clips should be plain and complement the uniform colours

- Headwear must be removed inside the buildings, excluding shaylas.
- Primary students are not permitted to wear makeup.

#### Swimming gear

- Swim caps are an expectation for all students.
- School issue swimsuits are not compulsory.
- It is recommended that students have their own pair of goggles for swimming.
- Students must bring their own towel, goggles and swim cap in a drawstring bag.

**Final decisions on what constitutes the proper uniform are at the discretion of the Principal.**

### **MIDDLE SCHOOL (GRADES 7-9) and HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS (GRADES 11-12)**

Standard School Uniform – to be purchased through Trutex

- MCIS shirts are red MCIS polo shirts or light blue button down, long-sleeve shirts.
- MCIS trousers are navy blue.
- Uniform shirts are to be worn at all times, even under hoodies.
- All buttons on shirts need to be done up appropriately.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- Standard school uniform must be worn at all times.

Hoodies/Jacket/Sweater – to be purchased through Trutex

- Students can only wear official school hoodies, jackets and sweaters and they should be navy blue in colour.
- Non-MCIS jumpers, sweaters and hoodies are not permitted.
- Official senior jackets are permitted, provided the correct MCIS uniform is worn underneath at all times.

PE Uniform – to be purchased through Trutex

- Standard PE uniform is the PE shirt and shorts or tracksuit bottoms.
- Plain black, white or red long sleeves and/or leggings may be worn under the regular PE uniform.
- Sports appropriate footwear must be worn.
- Middle and High School students will change into their PE kits on PE days, and change back into regular uniforms after lesson.

Hair/Headwear and Jewellery

- Hair should be neat and not of a distracting nature to the student or others.
- Jewelry should be minimal and plain (no dangling earrings).
- Items such as shaylas, belts and hair clips should be plain and compliment the uniform colours (white, red or black)
- Headwear must be removed inside the buildings, excluding shaylas.
- Make-up is limited to natural foundation, eyeliner, mascara and natural/ clear lip colour.

#### Swimming gear

- Swim caps are an expectation for all students.
- Girls' swimsuits must be one piece only.
- Swim-shorts with a waist drawstring for boys.
- It is recommended that students have their own pair of goggles for swimming.
- School issue swimsuits are not compulsory.

#### Footwear

- Middle School students may wear shoes, not sandals and should be closed-toe. Crocs are not allowed.
- Open-toe shoes or shoes without a full back are not permitted.

#### **Consequences for not following the MCIS' Uniform Policy:**

1. Homeroom or 1st Period teacher will give a verbal reminder/warning to the student. An email will be sent home regarding uniform violation.
2. After the second warning from the Homeroom or 1st Period teacher, a Written Warning Letter will be sent home regarding repeated uniform violations.
3. Grade level Coordinator will meet with the parents to discuss the repeated violation (after the 3rd non-compliance, and the student will be sent home.
4. Repeated violations will result in a one-day suspension from school.
5. If the offense continues, the student will be suspended from school for three days.

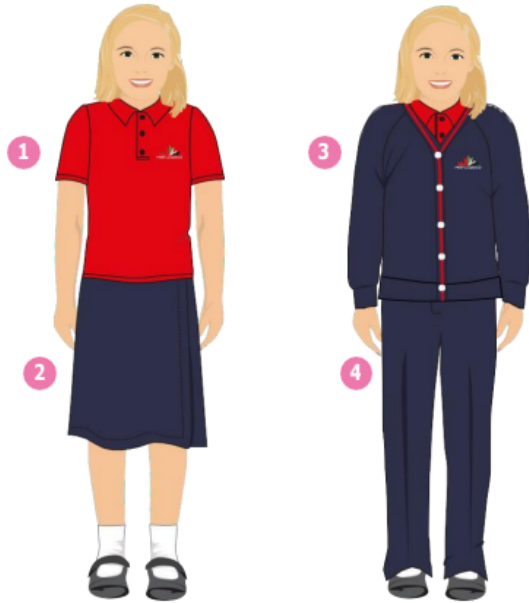
#### **Students Responsibilities:**

- If there are any medical reasons why wearing the school is difficult or needs to be modified to fit that individual's needs, provide medical information or a letter from the doctor.
- Provide students with the proper School Uniform apparel.
- Assist the student in keeping his or her uniform and personal hygiene clean and neat.
